Background on Gaga Ball

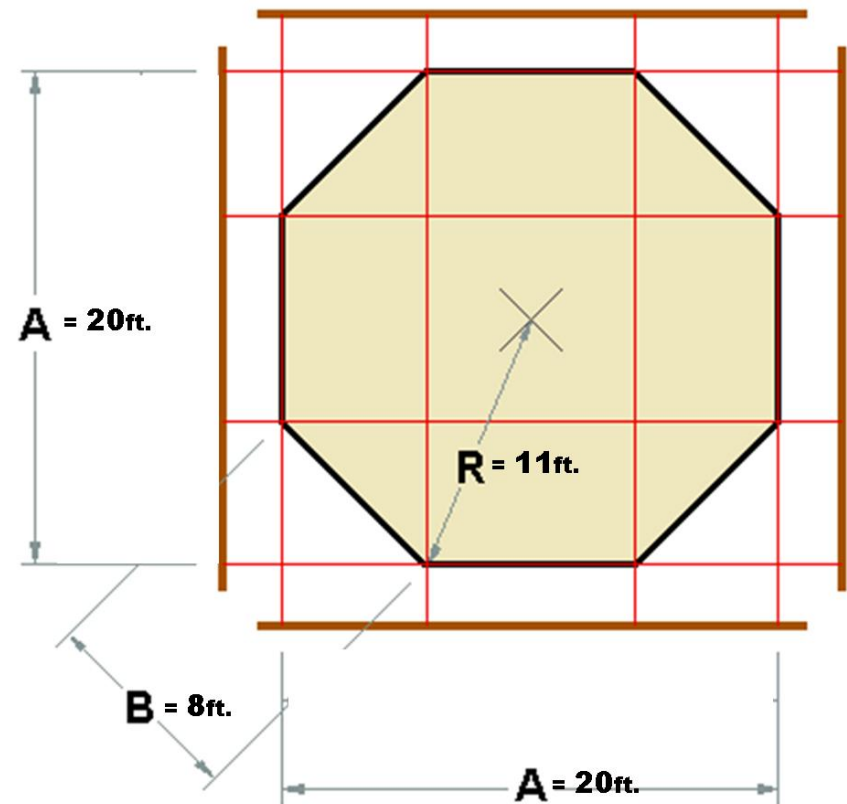
- Gaga Ball consists of a lightweight bouncy ball and an octagon enclosure known as the 'Gaga Ball Pit'

Gaga Pit Structure Specifications

- 20 ' Diameter Octagon
- 2" x 10" x 8' Structural Composite Lumber
- 30" high walls



Location Requirements

- Gaga Pits may be installed on
 - Asphalt
 - Concrete
 - Sand field

- Area must be level

- No grass installations



Surface Requirements

- Asphalt or Concrete installation requires rubber tile surfacing



- Sand field installation requires honeycomb rubber tile surfacing

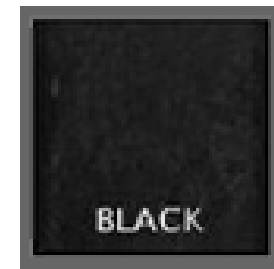
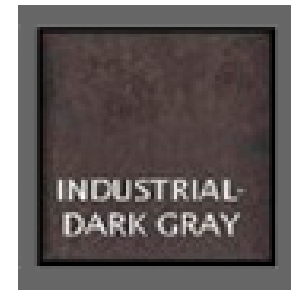


Customize Your Pit

- Structural Composite Wood is available in three colors



Approximate Costs (April 2018)

□ Structural Composite Lumber	\$2,500
■ Costs will vary as cost of material fluctuates	
□ Bracket System	\$525
□ Rubber Tile Surfacing	\$1,200
□ Honeycomb Rubber Tile Surfacing (Sand)	\$1,400
□ Taxes & Shipping	\$1,000
□ Installation – Asphalt/Concrete	\$500
□ Installation – Sand Field	\$1,000
■ Total Approx. Cost	\$5,700 - \$6,500
